Malvern Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty Viewpoints

Both wider and LSCA study areas lie entirely within view corridors from Exceptional VPs 40, 47, 48, 49 and 50, and Special VPs 24 and 26 – all on Malvern Hills ridgeline apart from VP40 (Obelisk at Eastnor Castle).

Both wider and LSCA study areas lie entirely within view corridor from Special VP45 (view from Durlow Common to Malvern Hills).

Part of wider study area and whole of LSCA study area lie within view corridor from Exceptional VP27 (view from Marcle Ridge to Malvern Hills).
